



ROSALIND FRANKLIN UNIVERSITY NAMES FIRST FEMALE DEAN OF CHICAGO MEDICAL SCHOOL

NORTH CHICAGO, IL, May 5, 2020 — Archana “Archie” Chatterjee, MD, PhD, a nationally recognized educator, researcher and specialist in pediatric infectious diseases, has been named dean of Chicago Medical School and vice president for medical affairs at Rosalind Franklin University of Medicine and Science.

Dr. Chatterjee, who assumed her new roles on April 6, is the first woman to serve as dean of CMS, founded in 1912. She is also the first female dean of a U.S. medical school with reported Indian descent, according to data from the Association of American Medical Colleges (AAMC). She joins RFU from University of South Dakota Sanford School of Medicine (USD SSOM)/Sanford Children’s Specialty Clinic, where she served as professor and chair for the Department of Pediatrics.
